



The Parks Primary Academy Sport Premium Report 2016-2017

In 2016/2017 The Parks Primary Academy will receive the fourth year instalment of PE funding. The funding will be used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning across the whole academy. We will encourage pupils to continue to lead healthy lifestyles, enjoy PE and Sport and experience high quality teaching. They will be encouraged to take part in competition and aim for sporting excellence. Over the past 4 years we have employed a specialist teacher to work alongside our teachers to develop their skills and knowledge to enhance the quality of the teaching of physical education.

Having already seen impact of the funding from the previous 3 years we hope for this additional funding to have continued and sustained impact on provision of PE and sport within our academy. Learning walks, lesson observations and monitoring by SLT and the PE leader as well as a termly PE report, have identified the following areas to address in PE coaching this year: high quality coaching in EYFS and KS1, increased awareness of healthy lifestyles, increased quality of warm ups and agility games to build up stamina. Pupils will also have many opportunities to participate in competitive events in various locations.
