

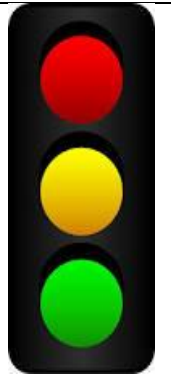


Behaviour - Traffic Lights
